What3Words

The Post Code we list for each of our sites, is the nearest one to their location.

In the event of the emergency services needing to be called, we have added What3Words references for all our sites on our website and will also be adding these to the site notice boards. These are more accurate than just the Post Code. By providing the emergency services with this information, they can use the reference to navigate and find the site.

You can download the free What3Words app, on your mobile, from the Google Play Store or the Apple Store.



Wildlife





Wildlife is precious and some help pollinate the crops we grow. To help our wildlife we have some dedicated wildlife areas at four of our sites and these are managed by volunteers for the benefit of wildlife.

When planting, consider perhaps adding a few nectar flowers for the bees and butterflies. Perhaps add a small wildlife pond to encourage frogs. They are good at eating slugs. If you add a pond, please do not make it too deep for site safety.



MAMC Website & Facebook

Our current website needed to be moved to a new server, which could have resulted in costs for MAMC.

With the help of Ben Kirby and Kayo, our website hosting provider, we have managed to agree moving the site to a new server for free.

As part of the move, we are going to review the entire website and make some changes. Shops

At the AGM, there was mention of the 5 shops we have, where they are etc. There was some confusion about who runs them, and whether they are part of the overall MAMC.

MAGA (Maidstone Allotments Garden Association) was formed when the allotments were run and controlled by Maidstone Borough Council, who still own the allotment land. If there was a problem on any plot or site, MAGA could represent them. All allotment holders were, and still are, automatically a member of the association. Representatives on each site were appointed by MAGA.

When the day to day running of the sites was handed over to MAMC (Maidstone Allotments Management Committee), site managers and reps were appointed and ratified by the allotment holders at the AGM.

MAGA still exists for the benefit of all plot holders. There is a small committee who has responsibility of the shops, headed by Nick Tomsett (Sandling Road). Nick runs and controls all the shops and the stock. Shops on other sites are run by volunteers from that particular site. Although all stock is sold at very competitive prices, all finance is in a separate MAGA bank account, with a treasurer in control. This is completely independent of MAMC, and does not form part of its finances.

Commodities sold in the shops include composts, manure, fertilisers such as Growmore, blood fish and bone, chicken manure and good quality canes. Seasonally, seed potatoes, onion setts and garlic are available. In Autumn, a big discount can be had for seeds from Kings Seeds, if ordered through MAGA. Details will be put on notice boards at the appropriate time.

Shops are to be found on Sandling Road, Upper Fant, Loose Road, Glebe and Rocky Hill. If your site does not have a shop, you can arrange to go to any of the above sites. Ask your site Manager for details.
